Name

- A. Tab
- B. Screw
- C. Battery compartment lid
- D. Coin cell battery
- E. Switch

Turning on

1. Grasp the tab and pull it out.

How to replace the battery

- 2. Use a cross head screwdriver to remove the screw of the battery compartment lid.
- 3. Replace the coin cell (CR2032) as shown in the diagram. Make sure to insert it in the proper positive/negative (+/-) direction.

Mode setting

- 4. Flickering light when slid to the left.
 - → Regular light when slid to the right.

Note:

- •Do not apply excessive force to the light switch.
- Doing so may damage or distort it.
- •The included battery is for test purposes. When the light starts to get dim, replace the battery (coin cell [CR2032]).
- •Battery life is approximately 15 hours of continuous lighting.
- •The battery life could shorten depending on the battery type, capacity, and the way in which they're used.

BATTERY CAUTIONS:

Requires 1 x CR2032 3V battery, included.

Do not mix old and new batteries.

Do not mix alkaline, standard(carbon-zinc), or rechargeable batteries. Do not use rechargeable batteries. Non-rechargeable batteries are not be recharged.

This product contains a Button or Coin Cell Battery. A swallowed Button or Coin Cell Battery can cause internal chemical burns in as little as two hours and lead to death.
